Bainbridge Community Broadcasting (BCB) has joined BARN as part of the newly formed Media Arts Studio. BCB's experienced team of volunteer podcasters and videographers will continue their popular community programming, as well as teach classes and workshops on social media, video, and audio recording.

Later this year, BCB will move from its current facility on Hildebrand Lane to the newly constructed Media Arts studio at BARN's new facility. Barry Peters, founder and manager of BCB and studio lead for BARN Media Arts, said that "it's exciting to think how much easier it will be at BARN for anyone to consider volunteering as a BCB community podcaster or as a BARN video or social media producer."

Peters said that participants in upcoming Media Arts programs can learn about audio recording, and then use that skill to make a keepsake recording of an aging family member, or a podcast that can be sent out to the world. Or they can take a video course and learn how to produce short videos for their Facebook page or their website.

Founded in May of 2014 under the auspices of Sustainable Bainbridge, Bainbridge Community Broadcasting (BCB) is an all-volunteer nonprofit community podcasting project. In their first 2 years BCB volunteers have produced over 500 podcasts introducing Bainbridge Island events, individuals, activities and ideas to their listening community. 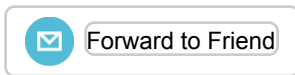
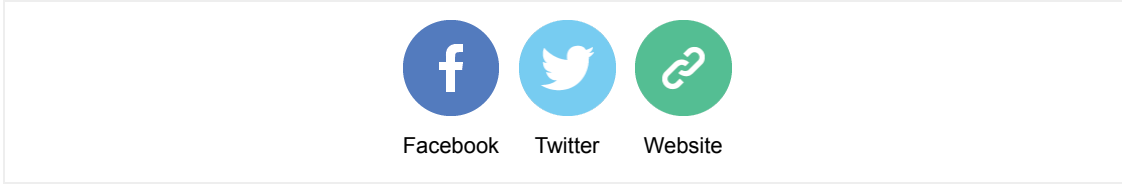
