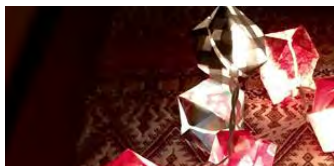

BARN partners with Flowering Around to light up the holidays



Beginning next week, visitors to Flowering Around, Winslow's beloved flower and gift shop, will notice a



origami lights strands and shiny copper cookie cutters. it's all part of a special partnership between Flowering Around and BARN.

Earlier this fall, BARN Fiber Arts volunteers came together to fold and assemble 1060 origami light holders from 6" x 6" squares of colorful paper. The holders were then placed over individual twinkly light bulbs, yielding colorful strings of light in 20 or 50-light strands, suitable for year-round display. BARN's Metal Arts group created beautiful copper cookie cutters.

The goal was to offer these to the public to help support BARN programs, but where? Enter Margi and Ashley Henry, the mother-daughter team that has owned Flowering Around for 20 years. BARN is so thankful for this new partnership with BAC! Here are just a few of the items on display:



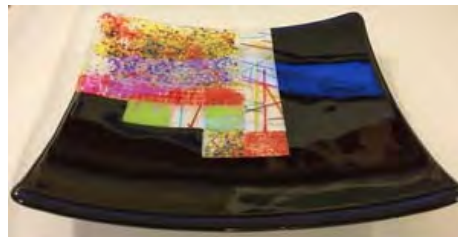
