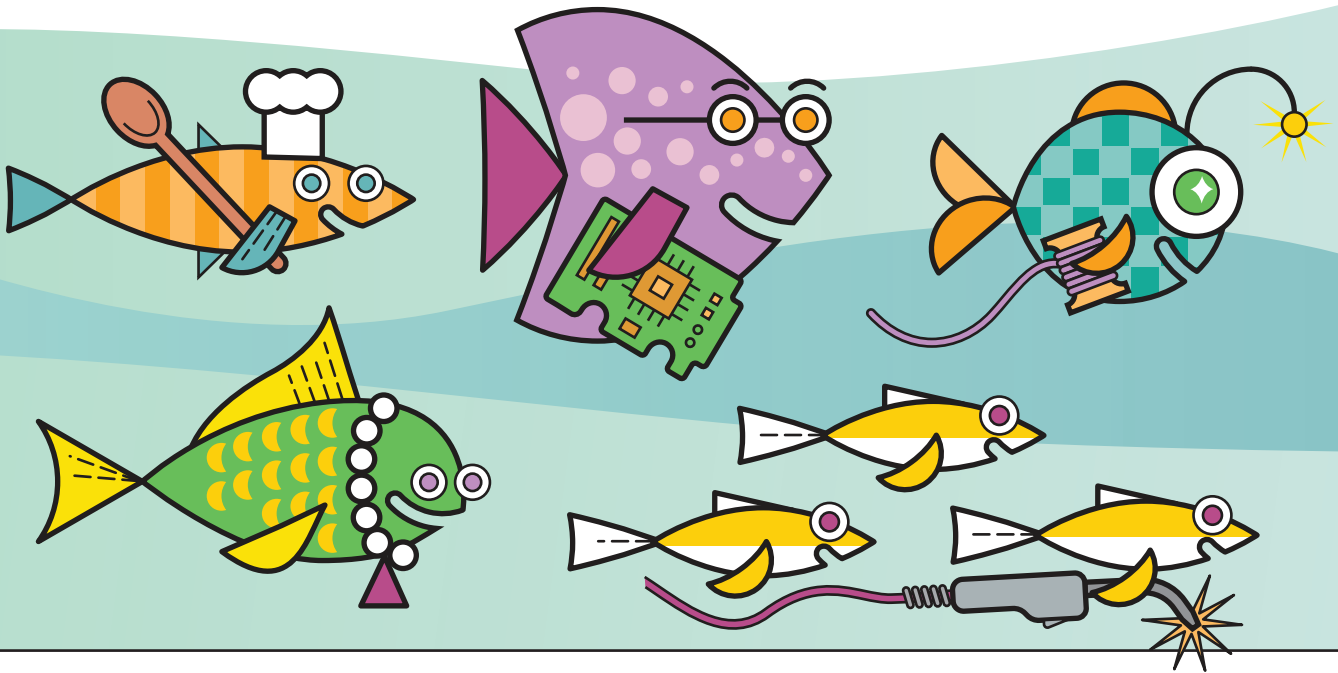

AGES	STUDIO	CLASS
10-14	Fiber	Owls! Masks and Pillows Use basic sewing skills to make an owl mask from felt. You can wear it on Halloween, or you can create other masks using the same techniques. Once we've made the mask, a cute owl pillow is next!
12-18	Kitchen	Mexican Cuisine 101 If you want to expand your culinary and barbecue skills, this is the place to be! Discover new ingredients, flavors and cooking methods, as well as the language and culture of Mexico.
12-18	Media	Short Film Challenge Tell a story in under two minutes in this short film challenge! Learn how to shoot and edit on your phone or tablet. No experience necessary, just bring your device and your imagination.
