

Job Description: Teen Night Assistant

Reports to: Youth Programs Coordinator

Responsibilities:

- Overall on-site support of Teen Night monthly program at BARN
- Assist with check-in at the front desk
- Assist with setup and cleanup
- Assist with planning and supervise a casual crafts activity for up to 16 participants
- Assist with food & beverages (food handler license preferred but not required)
- Pick up pre-ordered pizza for the event
- Other miscellaneous event-related tasks as needed

Qualifications:

- Experience working with youth ages 13-18
- Experience with making arts and crafts
- Comfortable using Google platforms
- Ability to remain calm and act quickly in a crisis is required
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills; ability to take initiative and problem-solve
- Available for all the event dates
- Driver's license and a reliable car
- Background check required

Pay Range: \$18 to \$20 per hour, depending on experience.

Hours: 4pm-10pm on-site for event nights. Some flexible remote support hours may also be available on a month-to-month basis.
